


Where Your Township Taxes Are Spent

Department Budgets for 2016 as approved by the Trustees



Capital Funds include tax dollars that have accumulated primarily from estate taxes over the years. The Township no longer receives estate taxes. Those funds were invested and saved for major projects or equipment such as the widening of main roads and intersections in the Township, purchase of land, construction of buildings, the purchase of fire trucks, ambulances and Police cars.

Since 2001, over 14 million dollars has been re-invested into our community from this fund in capital purchases and operating dollars for the Police Department. No levy tax dollars were used, no borrowing was needed, and no interest was paid. Some of the projects and items that were paid for are: the Safety Building, the new Highway Department and Vehicle Maintenance buildings, 3 fire trucks, 1 ambulance, 7 police cruisers, the Highmill / SR 236 improvements, a park truck and tractor and the purchase of 21.4 acres of new park land.

Total budgeted amount for all shown above is \$29,215,326 for 2016
