Whereas, by reason thereof, this board has determined that it will be necessary for the renewal of an existing tax of one (1.0) mill, which is in excess of such limitation, for the purpose of for parks and recreational purposes of Jackson Township, Stark County, Ohio for Jackson Township, Stark County, Ohio; and

Whereas, pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B), this Board as taxing authority for Jackson Township, Stark County, Ohio, is required to certify to the Stark County Auditor a resolution requesting that the Stark County Auditor certify to this Board as taxing authority for Jackson Township, Stark County, Ohio, the total current tax valuation of Jackson Township as a subdivision, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills. In addition, this Board as said taxing authority of said Township is required to state the purpose of the tax, whether the tax is an additional levy, a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, or a renewal or replacement of an existing tax with an increase or a decrease, the section of the Ohio Revised Code authorizing submission of the question of the tax, the term of years of the tax of it the tax is for a continuing period of time, that the tax is to be levied upon the entire territory of the subdivision or, if authorized by the Ohio Revised Code, a description of the portion of the territory of the subdivision in which the tax is to be levied, the date of the election at which the question of the tax shall appear on the ballot, tat the ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the subdivision or, if authorized by the Ohio Revised Code, a description of the portion of the territory of the subdivision to which the ballot measure shall be submitted, the tax year in which the tax will first be levied and the calendar year in which the tax will first be collected and each such county in which the subdivision has territory to the Stark County Board of Elections for determination as provided by law.
